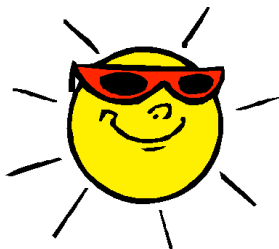

Planning for Richmond Continuing Education's Summer Learning 2016 for school-age students is underway. Here is some DRAFT information:

ACADEMIC FULL CREDIT SUMMER LEARNING (Grades 10-12, credit courses)

This intensive academic program is for school-age students taking a course for the first time, to improve a mark, or meet post-secondary prerequisites.

- Tuesday, July 5 - Friday, August 5 (no classes on Monday, August 1 – BC Day)
- Provincial Exams are August 8 – 12 (Eng. 10 & 12, Math 10, Science 10, Social Studies 11)

ACADEMIC REMEDIAL SUMMER LEARNING (Grades 8-11, credit courses)

This program is for school-age students who are incomplete, or with a 40-49% final school-based mark, or have the home school principal's recommendation.

- Tuesday, July 5 - Friday, July 29
- Provincial Exams are August 8 – 12 (Eng. 10, Math 10, Science 10, Social Studies 11)

ENRICHMENT ELEMENTARY & SECONDARY SUMMER LEARNING

(Grades 1-12, non-credit courses)

Enrichment non-credit courses are designed to include provincial learning outcomes for Grades 1-12: English, ELL/ESL, French, math, science and other subjects. School-age students will review and preview learning outcomes through intensive, professionally delivered courses.

SUMMER CAMPS (fee paying)

These professionally delivered camps will engage students in activities beyond the scope typical in most schools.
