EDI survey with UBC partnership coming up. Thank you for delivery of information on snow days and power outage and sending communication on WeChat.

High school transitioning already sent email to Grade 7 parents advising tomorrow night Spotlight on Palmer at 7pm. Rail and Incentive program speakers will be there. Deadline for Grade 7 course selections due Friday January 26, 2024.

Fencing around soccer box. Parking blocks were removed. After school parking lot pickup, no place for people to park. Had by law visitor come and in one day gave 9 warning infractions.

Only Palmer will come to talk about the school. If interested in other high schools, parents can look at Richmond district website to see other high school programs, but you will have to apply because out of catchment.

Grade 4 and Grade 7 will be doing learning surveys happening in February. Opportunity for parents to provide feedback as well.

Ms. Norman – Feeding Futures program and Food Bank program. Schools are having fridges delivered and installed to have communal food. Monthly food shipments to fill the fridge. If students are hungry it is there. Initial months is feeding frenzy but then quiets down. Removes stigma. Government supported.

Ms. Wong – Lots of different clubs, chess club, crochet club, choir etc. and lots of opportunities for kids to join. Strongly encourage kids to volunteer. Basketball is for Grade 6 and 7. When lacking interest may open to Grade 5.

Staffing: Ms. Tang had her baby boy Isaac. Ms. Titifanua is returning after Spring Break. Have Ms. Bruschetta Mon-Wed and Ms. Lam is doing Thurs Fri. With Ms. Tang's position there are some challenges filling her position and we have Teacher On Call Lynne Wilkinson until Spring Break.

Reminder extended leaves of absences. 20 days holding tight to that. Waiting for Spirit Wear. For 75th anniversary planning, need to start. Have May 23, 2024 as date. There will be parent meeting for Grade 7 parents in April.
